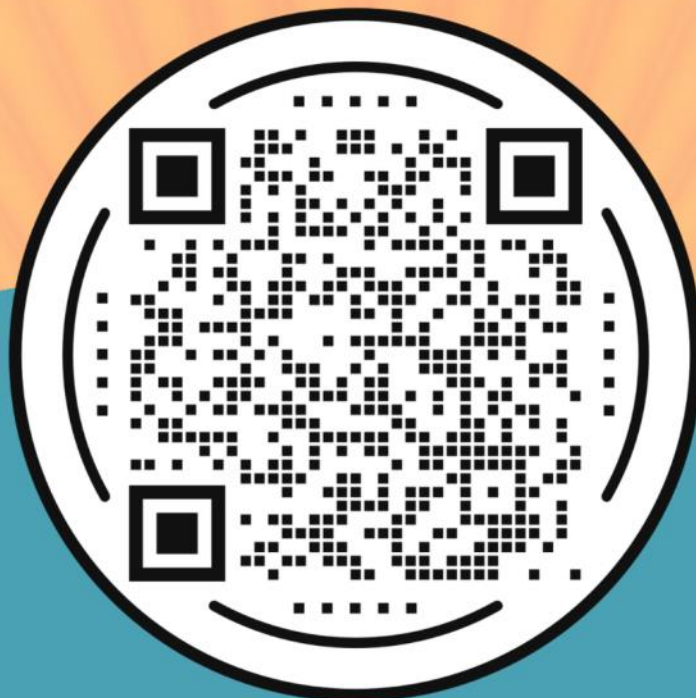

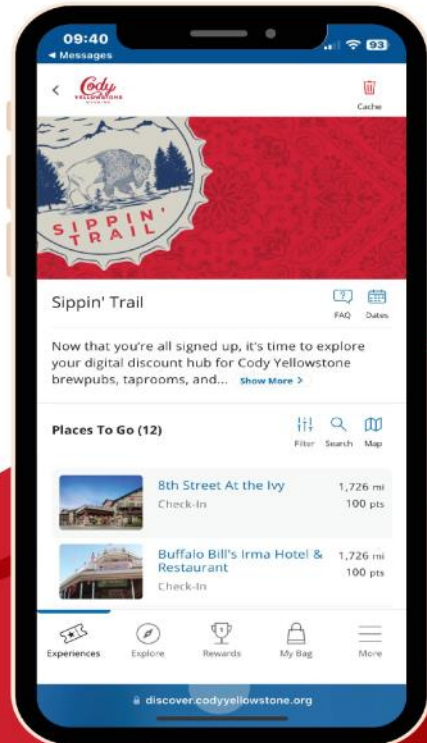

Don't forget we now have a variety of Board Games available at the library. These do NOT have to be checked out, you don't need a library card. Take a game, play it, bring it back, take a different one.

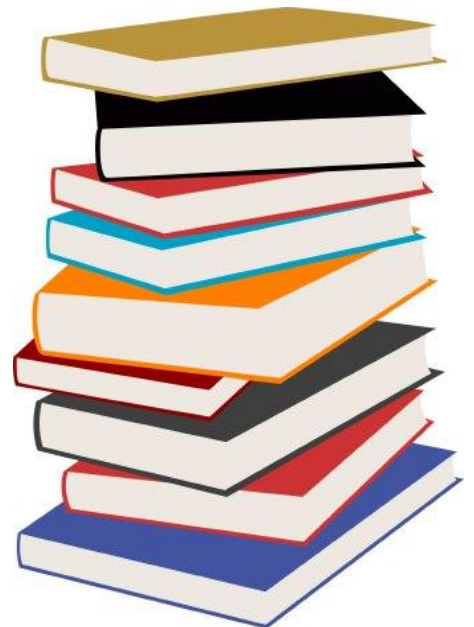
