

Staff Spotlight

Christine Horsen

Mrs. Horsen is a Wyoming girl. She was born and raised in Wyoming. However, her first teaching job was in American Samoa. She said that living on a small island wasn't right for a Wyoming girl. Her next teaching experience was on the Navajo Reservation. Eventually, she made it back to Wyoming in our very own Meeteetse. Her children have graduated from Meeteetse School, and she is proud of what the school has been able to offer.

Mrs. Horsen started at Meeteetse School, teaching 1st grade. Since then, she has taught kindergarten, and revolutionized teaching at the upper elementary level when she and Mrs. Schlenker team taught a combined 3rd, 4th, and 5th-grade class. She is the current reading and instructional coach at the school. In this capacity, she works with teachers to better develop their reading instruction skills, and with students to enhance their reading skills.

Working with "the most incredible staff" is the highlight of her work. Mrs. Horsen's duties don't end in the school. She spends one morning a week at the pre-school rec kids program teaching a love of reading. She is a lifeguard at the swimming pool and runs our concession stand. These are just the things that are visible. She serves so many in our community in an out-of-the-spotlight manner.

The advice that Mrs. Horsen would like to share with our families is, "read every day to your kids. It doesn't matter if they are young or old. Have them do the dishes and read to them while they wash." She also encourages parents to be positive about learning. Your attitudes will be seen in your kids.






