

**The Library has fun events planned for every month!** Stay tuned here for our events, check for flyers at the Post Office, watch for our Facebook posts (find Meeteetse, Park County Libraries and "Follow or Like" our page - lots of info there!) or come up to the Library and ask! We always enjoy a visit and sharing what's going on! **ALL** of our programs are Free and Open to the Public! If you have questions, you can always call us at 868-2248.

The school is on Spring Break but we're **OPEN at the library!** Come up and find a book to read or movie to watch while you wait for snow to melt and temperatures to warm! Coming up on **Friday, April 5 at 2:00 Park County Treasurer Barb Poley** will be at the library to talk about the **State of Wyoming Property Tax Relief Programs** - What's new this year? How do you qualify? When do you apply? Who's eligible? If you've got questions, she's got answers.


It's **Tax Time**! The library has **1040 and 1040 SR forms and instruction booklets** available. If you need other forms, we can find and print them for you. We also have a comprehensive tax preparation book available for check out. If you need, or want, help with tax preparation, the Cody Library has partnered with VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) to offer FREE tax assistance to individuals, families, and persons with disabilities. If your income is \$68,000 or less, you're eligible for this invaluable service! Appointments are available from January 30 through April 10. Call the **Cody Library at 307-527-1880** to schedule an appointment.

The Park County Libraries have **Blood Pressure Cuffs** available for check out. These are supplied in cooperation with the University of Wyoming Center on Aging. In an effort to gather user feedback on the program, anyone checking out a Blood Pressure Cuff from April 1 through June 8 is encouraged to fill out a **survey and be entered into a weekly drawing for a \$100 gift card!** Get to know your numbers **and** have a chance to win a prize! Come up to the Meeteetse Library and check one out.




